

Things that have happened to me because my name is Mark S Zuckerberg:
(I give it Zero Likes!)

- I was sued by the State of Washington due to mistaken identity – they thought I was the Facebook founder who was accused of endangering an adult in need of services (See Attached)
- My Facebook account is constantly hacked, and I am asked to reset my password multiple times a day. (See Attached)

- I receive phone calls at my office every day from people demanding tech support or help with Facebook, from resets to removing photos to locked accounts.
- I was once a trivia question on *Who Wants to Be a Millionaire*: What Midwest attorney shares the same name as a famous software developer?”

- While speaking in Las Vegas, a limo-driver was waiting for me at the bottom of the escalator with a sign for “Mark Zuckerberg” causing chaos as a large disappointed crowd had been waiting
- My life sometimes feels like the Michael Jordan ESPN commercial, where a regular person’s name causes constant mix-ups
- I was removed from the *Nextdoor* App for “using a fake name” (See Attached)
- My personal Facebook account has been disabled five times because Facebook accused me of impersonating a celebrity and using a fake name

- My office's Facebook business page, The Bankruptcy Law Office of Mark Zuckerberg, P.C. has been disabled four times for the same reason
- On *23andMe*, I have over 753 "relatives", many of whom immediately request money or ask for favors
- I routinely receive death threats and harassment on the app Messenger directed toward the *other* Mark Zuckerberg (See Attached)
- I get Venmo payment requests and money solicitations from total strangers (See Attached)
- I was contacted by a TV show exploring people who share the same famous name with the premise of switching lives/jobs for a day
- I appeared in a Harvard Law School textbook as a case study about losing your own identity when you have the same name as a celebrity
